## Cheesy Waffles Project ALCOHOL POLICY (In House)



Our adult members are encouraged to engage in social time with friends by visiting restaurants, pubs and places of interest as well as enjoying social time at the Community Centre, Skills House and Belmont Social Club.

Part of this is enabling members who wish to have an alcoholic drink to enjoy in a safe environment.

## In order to ensure project members are kept safe, staff must:

- Have Parent/Carer Consent for any members (over 18 years) to consume alcohol
- Ensure there is a 2-drink maximum for regular clubs (2 hours long) and 3-drink maximum for longer sessions e.g. offsite trips and residentials (3+ hours long)
- Monitor each individual to check on the influence of alcohol (most parents/carers will say they are only allowed 1 drink etc. so must be checked)
