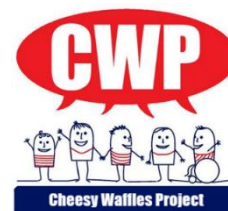


Cheesy Waffles Project

- Encourage good behaviour


Staff, Volunteers and Members of the Project
